111 COUNT NOUNS

- A Count Nouns: Meaning and Form
 - 1 You can count most nouns and make the words plural.
 - We use a or an before a singular count noun. A/An means 'one.'
 We put a before a consonant sound and put an before a vowel sound.



CAREFULD We use a/an based on the sound, not the spelling: an hour [auər] a uniform [júːnəfɔːrm]

12 NON-COUNT NOUNS

- A Non-count Nouns: You can't count these nouns.
 - Names of materials



- 2 Things you can't see or touch: *love, time, advice, homework, information, news,* etc.
 - Let me give you some **advice**.
 - I have good **news** for you.
 - This is hard work.
- 3 Names of people, places, days, and months: Always use a capital letter!
 - John, Paris, Tuesday, August, etc.
